On The Cross

In Sequence As He Spoke Them

Luke 23:34 - Then said Jesus, Father, **F**orgive **T**hem; for they know not what they do.

Matthew 27:46 - And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, **W**hy hast thou **F**orsaken me?

Luke 23:43 - And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, **T**o day shalt thou be with me in **P**aradise.

John 19:28 - After this, Jesus knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the scripture might be fulfilled, saith, **I** **T**hirst.

John 19:30 - When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, **I** **I**s **F**inished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.

•These last two phrases were actually spoken by the Lord at nearly the same time and each Gospel Writer captured just a fragment of Jesus' words.

Luke 23:46 - And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, **F**ather, into **T**hy **H**ands I **C**ommend my **S**pirit: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost.
